Our dementia specialist Admiral Nurses are a lifeline for families affected by dementia. Your donation will help grow the number of nurses across the UK so no one has to face dementia alone.



£3 could cover the telephone costs of a person living with dementia calling our free national Dementia Helpline for support.



£15 could cover the telephone costs of five families affected by dementia calling our Helpline.



£30 could pay for a specialist dementia nurse to advise two



£225 could fund a new specialist dementia nurse to run a full day of face-to-face

families in virtual clinic sessions so that they can better support the person they care for.



£44 could pay for a carer to receive an hour of one-to-one support from a specialist Helpline nurse.

appointments for families affected by young onset dementia (where symptoms develop under the age of 65).



£390 could keep our Helpline running at full capacity for an hour, supporting families in urgent need of expert dementia support.



£1,125 could fund a new specialist dementia nurse for a whole week to support a community where people are struggling to access local dementia services.
